Learned counsel files the fresh power of attorney on behalf of the petitioner, superseding the earlier counsel.

This is a petition that has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the order dated 26.05.2016 passed by the learned SDJM, Payal whereby interim maintenance has been allowed @ ₹ 7500/- per month as well as order dated 06.01.2018 dismissing the revision application.

It is contended that the amount of interim maintenance that has been assessed is on the lower side.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, with a direction to the trial court to decide the matter expeditiously, on account of the fact that expenses of the minor have to be borne.

I heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Dismissed as withdrawn, leaving it open to the petitioner herein to take all the pleas available to him in the trial court regarding the quantum of maintenance. The trial court, which is seized of the matter, is directed to decide the matter in a time bound manner.
