ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 48 dated 11.08.2017, registered under Sections 376(2)(n), 313, 506 IPC, Women Police Station Panipat, District Panipat.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that Kuldeep and Neeraj were related and Kuldeep husband of the prosecutrix had died and the allegations made by the complainant are that there was a promise of marriage and he had physical relations with her and later on refused to marry her. Counsel contends that investigation is over and challan has been presented and the petitioner is younger to the complainant.

Both the parties are adults. The main allegationis of false promise of marriage. It is not clear whether any DNA test was carried out. The investigation is over and challan has been presented. Without

commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
