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**RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)**

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.121 dated 27.04.2017 (Annexure P1) registered under Sections 295,323,324,148 read with Section 149 IPC at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, on the basis of compromise dated 25.07.2017 (Annexure P3).

Pursuant to order dated 16.04.2018 of this Court, the parties appeared before Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala on 15.05.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala, has submitted her report vide letter bearing No.63 dated 19.05.2018 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Kapurthala, vide Endst. No.894 dated 21.05.2018.

According to the report, learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is

genuine, voluntary, without any coercion or undue influence with their free will.

Considering the report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala dated 19.05.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.121 dated 27.04.2017 (Annexure P1) registered under Sections 295,323,324,148 read with Section 149 IPC at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala is hereby quashed, subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/-, out of which Rs.6,000/- shall be deposited with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority and Rs.4,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
