1. CRM-M No.4077 of 2018 was decided by this Court on 21.03.2018 after taking into consideration the compromise effected between the parties after registration of the case. The said compromise was signed by the complainant herself.
2. According to that compromise, three cheques were given by Gaurav Sood in favour of Kuldeep Singh. On presentation, the said cheques were dishonoured. In respect of two cheques, complaints were filed by Kuldeep Singh and the same are pending. Kuldeep Singh has already been arrested.
3. Anticipatory bail in favour of Chand Singh was allowed vide the aforesaid order.
4. Complainant-petitioner seeks to assail the aforesaid

order on the ground that the documents (Annexures P-2 and P-3) were not available at the relevant time and the same were obtained under Right to Information Act.

5. In my considered opinion, the aforesaid documents cannot advance the case of prosecution for reviving or recalling order dated 21.03.2018 passed by this Court.

6. This petition is accordingly, dismissed.
