Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. and seeks regular bail in FIR No.113 dated 13.06.2017 under Sections 302/34 IPC, P.S. Civil Lines, Batala, District Batala in which he is in custody since 15.06.2017. It is not disputed that challan has been presented. As per affidavit filed by the State, the cause of death as per the report of Chemical Examiner is as under:

“5. That it is respectfully submitted that the report of Chemical Examiner to Govt. Punjab was received in the office of Senior Superintendent of Police on 4.2.2018 and as per the report ORGANOPHOSPHORUS compound detected in the contents of exhibits II, III, IV & V. No poison detected in the contents of exhibits I.”

The counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the only allegation as such against the petitioner is that he along with others had taken the deceased Bharat Bhushan with him, who was working with

Krishna DJ system. The deceased had not returned home and Tara Singh had called the family members that Bharat Bhushan was with him and that he would drop him back. The deceased did not reach back home and was found dead in the house of Tara Singh on the next day which had been locked.

Keeping in view the above, bail application is allowed and petitioner is admitted to regular bail, subject to furnishing of adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Gurdaspur.
