This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.132, dated 09.10.2017, under Sections 452/324/323/506/427/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code added later on), registered at Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

2. Seen Case Diary along with fresh complaint of the complainant referred to in the earlier order dated 22.01.2018, which is produced before this Court.

3. Also seen the Video Recording of the occurrence as mentioned in the last para of the aforesaid fresh complaint/representation dated 01.01.2018.

4. Considering the available material against the petitioner and in view of the submission on behalf of the State that inspite of having been granted interim anticipatory bail, he is not cooperative with the investigation, since he does not disclose the names of the other assailants as seen in the Video Recording, this Court is not inclined to grant the extraordinary favour of anticipatory bail to him.

5. Consequently, the present petition is dismissed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner earlier is recalled.
