Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.142 dated 25.12.2017 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Kathu Nangal, Amritsar, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, the complainant has given Rs.7.00 lacs to the petitioner in the year 2014, whereas the FIR was registered in 2017. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial lockup since 28.12.2017, challan has already been presented and the offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of custody certificate, has not disputed the aforesaid factual position.

Without commenting on merits of the case, considering the fact

that the petitioner is in judicial lockup since 28.12.2017; he is not involved in any other case; investigation is complete and challan has been presented; offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate and conclusion of the trial will take some time, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition is disposed of.
