ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

This is the second petition filed by the petitioner seeking regular bail in FIR No.120 dated 06.03.2017, under Section 304-B, 498-A, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar (Haryana). The first bail petition was withdrawn on 16.01.2018 after the complete arguments had been made and this Court was not inclined to grant relief.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody for over a year and now an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. has been filed which would further delay the trial.

The State counsel informs that the incident has occurred within one and a half year of marriage and the girl had died by hanging in the matrimonial home and she had left behind a suicide note and on the date of incident the petitioner had gone to the house of the complainant and had asked for a sum of Rs.50,000/- and had given warning that if the amount was not paid then he would kill Suman.

Information regarding the death was received by the
parents at about 5:00 P.M. on the same day. The allegations are
serious. No case for bail is made out. The petition is dismissed.
