Through this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petition has sought direction to respondents No.1 and 2 for transfer of investigation to any independent investigating agency for a free and fair investigation in case FIR No.13 dated 21.03.2017 for offence under Sections 302, 120-B of IPC registered at Police Station Naya Gaon, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) as respondents No.5 and 6 in connivance with respondent No.3 by using police power has not arresting the real culprits inspite being FIR registered against them.

Fresh status report by way of affidavit of Raminder Singh, PPS, Superintendent of Police (Investigation), Rupnagar has already been filed by learned State counsel, which transpires that petitioner is not reporting for investigation though notices under Section 160 Cr.P.C. have already been issued to her.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is ready to participate in the investigation. As such, this petition is disposed of with direction to the respondents that in case petitioner appears before them her grievance shall be heard. Petitioner is directed to submit her grievance in writing, and those shall be considered and disposed of in accordance with law.
