Petitioner has sought for the following relief:

“Petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. Seeking direction to official respondents to conduct fair, impartial and speedy investigation in FIR No.0046 dated 5.11.2017 U/s 323, 325, 148, 149 IPC, Police Station Sadar Pathankot, Tehsil and District Pathankot (P-2) and to take strict action against the accused/respondents No.5 to 9.

Furtehr direction be issued to official respondents to protect life and liberty of petitioner and family members from respondents No.3 and 4 who are continuously harassing the petitioner (physically as well as mentally) under the garb of conducting investigation by entering the house of petitioner after sunset intentionally with the knowledge that the petitioner is residing all alone in her house as the husband is a military officer presently post in Ladakh.”

2. After service of notice, official respondents have acted upon petitioner's grievance. On 4.4.2018, challan has been filed. Further on 7.9.2018, official respondents have given an undertaking that petitioner

would be extended protection. Having regard to the aforesaid development, petition do not survive for consideration. If any other grievance is still to be considered by the official respondents, petitioner is directed to make necessary representation. If such representation is made, concerned official respondent is hereby directed to consider at the earliest.

3. Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
