Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.11 dated 02.02.2018, under Sections 323, 354-B, 216, 506 IPC and Section 3 of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, registered at Police Station Sanoli, District Panipat.

Perusal of the FIR would reveal that the present petitioner has beaten up the complainant and has employed cast related derogatory words/abuses against the complainant and has even dragged her by pulling her hair.

In the light of specific Bar contemplated under Section 18 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner the concession of anticipatory bail.

Petition dismissed.
