As per allegations in the FIR, petitioner gave an iron rod blow below knee of the right leg of Sultan Snigh. Three fractures were found on the right leg and one fracture was found on the left leg of Sultan Singh. Medical opinion received by the police is in respect of causing grievous injuries to the complainant.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Davinder Singh submitted that offence under Section 325 IPC has already been added on 25.04.2018 and recovery of iron rod is to be effected besides names of other unknown persons are

to be known from the petitioner.

At this stage, complicity of the petitioner viz-a-viz offence under Section 307 IPC would be debatable.

In view of aforesaid, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 11.05.2018 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on bail, on his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer subject to the following conditions:-

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required:
2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.
