Petitioner-Ajit Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.108 dated 31.07.2017, registered at Police Station Baragudha, under Sections 326, 195, 182, 201, 120-B, 34, 211 and 182 of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant have appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for both the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Perusal of the record shows that one Bihari Lal got registered the FIR against Ramesh Kumar, Bhal Singh, Daya Ram, Perhlad Singh and Bijli @ Vijay. On investigation, that FIR was found false and then Bihari Lal was made accused under Sections 195, 182 IPC etc. The allegation against the present petitioner is that he was in conspiracy with Bihari Lal.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 11.04.2018, passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 11.04.2018, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
