This order shall dispose of CRM No.M-15000 of 2018 (Intzaar Vs. State of Haryana) and CRM No.M-15001 of 2018 (Yamin and others Vs. State of Haryana).

FIR has been registered on the complaint of ASI Ravinder.

Pleadings on record would indicate that Intzaar i.e. petitioner in CRM No.M-15000 of 2018 is an accused in FIR No.11 dated 02.02.2018, under Sections 323, 354-B, 216, 506 IPC and Section 3 of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Sanoli, District

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Panipat.

Precise allegations are that the petitioners/accused in CRM No.M-15001 of 2018 in connivance and conspiracy with co-accused Intzaar had scuffled with the police party, interfered in the performance of the duties and thereby facilitated in the escape of Intzaar.

State counsel upon instructions from ASI Kulbir Singh submits that in the alleged occurrence, 03 police officials had also suffered injuries.

Against the backdrop of the allegations and the conduct of the petitioners, the prayer for pre arrest bail is declined.

Both the petitions are dismissed.
