Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents No.4 and 5.

Vide order dated April 11, 2018, while issuing notice of motion to the respondents, this Court had directed the respondent No.2 Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

At this stage, learned State counsel has produced a photocopy of the joint affidavit furnished by the petitioners, namely, Kuldeep Kaur and Sukhchain Singh, wherein they have stated that the parents of Kuldeep Kaur are now happy with the marriage and the petitioners do not have any threat and as such, they are not in the need of any police protection. The petitioners

are living happily together as husband and wife at village Mushkved, P.S. Kotwali, Kapurthala. Photocopy of the said affidavit is taken on record.

Counsel for the petitioners does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

In view of the aforesaid development, the present petition is rendered as infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
