Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.5, who is threatening her to withdraw the complaint (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to look into the contents of the complaint dated 22.03.2018 (Annexure P-2).

On asking of the Court, Ms. Devaki Anand Sullar, A.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to look into the contents of the complaint dated 22.03.2018 (Annexure P-2) and dispose of the same within three months in accordance with law.
