Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 25.04.2017 (P-5) and provide adequate protection to the petitioner and his family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the purpose would be achieved if respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, is directed to look into representation (P-5) moved by the petitioner, in a time-bound manner.
