Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of order dated 25.5.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and cooperated during investigation to the extent that whatever questions were put to him, he has responded to each and every question.

Learned counsel for respondent-State on instructions from SI Vinod Kumar submits that recovery could not be effected from the petitioner.

A perusal of the allegations levelled in the FIR clearly shows that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR. Co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Sandeep Kumar @ Tony, Narender Nagar, Pardeep @

Faddy and Rajesh Kumar @ Raju, who were earlier released on regular bail,

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have been released on anticipatory bail after addition of Sections 467,468 and 471,201 and 120-B IPC. The allegations in the FIR are matter of evidence, which shall be seen by the trial Court.

Accordingly, interim order dated 20.4.2018 passed by this Court in favour of the petitioner is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
