Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of direction to respondents no.1 to 3 to register an FIR on the basis of complaints Annexures P-2 and P-3 against respondent no.4.

In compliance of the notice of motion issued by this Court, short reply by way of affidavit of Rajwinder Kaur, Inspector/SHO PS Sadar, Amritsar City on behalf of respondent no.1 has been filed, same is taken on record, copy, thereof, supplied to the counsel opposite. Perusal of paragraph 4 of the affidavit clearly reveals that daughter of petitioners namely Pushpinder Kaur was married with respondent no.4 on 11.10.2017 at Gurudwara Dashmesh Pita, Patshahi Dasvi (Regd.), village Singa Devi, Tehsil Kharar, District Mohali, Punjab and both are residing at Bangalore happily. Statement of Lakhbir Kaur recorded by the police is appended as Annexure R-2. It seems that petitioners are against the marriage of their daughter with respondent no.4 and that is the precise reason for filing of the present petition and there is no threat to life and liberty of the petitioners, at this stage.

In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to issue any

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further direction in the matter and the same is disposed off as such.

However, if the occasion so arises, the petitioners would be at liberty to approach this Court again.
