Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.7 dated 31.01.2018, under Section 489-B, 489-C, 420 IPC, Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur.

In the FIR, his name has been specifically mentioned alongwith Lakhvir Singh who was accordingly arrested on the basis of the said secret information. From the said co-accused 66 counterfeit currency notes of Rs.2,000/- denomination have been recovered. He has further disclosed and confirmed the factum of the secret information that the present petitioner had given him 75 counterfeit currency notes denomination. In such circumstances, the denial of the anticipatory bail by Addl. District Judge, Sangrur dated 20.02.2018 does not seems to be without any basis.

Accordingly, no case is made out to grant anticipatory bail and the present petition is dismissed in limine.
