AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner, in compliance with the order passed by this Court on 12.04.2018, has joined investigation, which fact is not disputed by counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar, Police Station City Hisar. He, however, states that the petitioner is the person with whom main accused, namely, Ritu Kumari and Vinod, have conspired to authenticate the forged documents to be genuine. He further contends that another person, Ashish Bansal, is the kingpin, against whom there are five other cases and his application for grant of bail has also not been accepted by this Court. He, therefore, contends that the petitioner be not granted the concession of anticipatory bail.

Having considered the submissions made by counsel for the parties and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner was an employee of

the Company itself and had only authenticated the documents, which were produced, to be genuine with those documents being in possession of the investigating agencies, custodial interrogation of the petitioner at this stage would not be required.

In view of the statement made by counsel for the State, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 12.04.2018 passed by this Court is confirmed. The petitioner shall, however, continue to join investigation as and when called for.
