The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of interim regular bail for a period of 02 months on medical grounds in case FIR No.28 dated 12.05.2017, registered under Sections 15 and 25 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Ajitwal, District Moga as he has to get conducted his spinal surgery.

Status report by way of affidavit of Amrik Singh, Superintendent, Sub Jail, Moga as well as medical report of petitioner have been filed. Same are taken on record.

As per medical report (Annexure A), the petitioner is advised Post Decompression and Fixation Surgery.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and also the medical condition of the petitioner, the present petition is allowed.

Petitioner Inderjit Singh is ordered to be released on interim regular bail for a period of 02 months, which will commence from the date of release of the

petitioner, on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Moga. However, the petitioner shall surrender before the concerned jail after a period of two months, after getting medical treatment.
