In the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioners seek directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for protecting the life and liberty and not to interfere in the peaceful married life of the petitioners, at the instance of private-respondents No.4 & 5.

It has been pleaded that date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 03.04.1996 and date of birth of petitioner No.2 is 29.08.1992, as per Aadhaar Cards (Annexure P-1 and 2). It is further pleaded that they have got married on 11.04.2018 as per Hindu rites and ceremonies at Yamunanagar. Photocopy of the marriage certificate duly attested by the counsel has been placed on record as Annexure P-3. The photographs of the marriage have been appended as Annexure P-4. It is further the case of the petitioners that representation dated 11.04.2018 (Annexure P-5) has been filed with respondent No.2 in this regard and resultantly the present petition has been filed.

After hearing counsel for the petitioners, without commenting upon the validity/legality of the marriage or the age of the petitioners and keeping in view the binding precedent of the Apex Court in ***Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478***, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to look into the above said representation filed by the petitioners and take appropriate action in accordance with law and provide protection, if so required.
