Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order passed by this Court on 27.04.2018, the petitioner has joined investigation and the same has been affirmed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Parmod Kumar.

The petitioner has been implicated in the case only on the basis of statement made by co-accused. The recovery has been shown to be effected in front of the house of the petitioner and no independent witness was joined at the time of alleged recovery. The recovery is non-commercial and no other case under NDPS Act is pending against the petitioner.

In view of submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, interim order dated 27.04.2018 passed by this Court in favour of the petitioner is made absolute.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
