Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.192 dated 03.10.2014 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 457/381 IPC and later on added Section 411 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Patiala, on the basis of compromise dated 16.10.2015(Annexures P-2 and P-3).

Pursuant to order dated 03.08.2016 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 17.08.2016 to get their statements recorded. Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.2030, dated 31.08.2016 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Patiala, vide Endst. No.5990/AL, dated 01.09.2016.

According to the report, learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala, is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is genuine, voluntary, without any coercion or undue influence with

their free will.

Considering the report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Patiala, dated 31.08.2016 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.192 dated 03.10.2014 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 457/381 IPC and later on added Section 411 IPC at Police Station Sadar, Patiala, is quashed, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, out of which ₹6,000/- shall be deposited with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority and ₹4,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana High Court.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
