Mr. Parminder Singh-I, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the
complainant by filing vakalatnama, which be taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the matter has since
been compromised between the parties and a petition bearing No. CRM-M-
22107-2018 for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise has been filed, in
which the parties have been directed to get their statements recorded as regard the
compromise before Illaqa Magistrate and next date of hearing is fixed as
17.08.2018. Photocopy of the order dated 22.05.2018 passed in that petition has
been placed on record.

Heard.

Briefly stated the facts of the case as per prosecution are that on 16.03.2018 when complainant Harjit Singh was sitting with his friends in his office at about 06:15 p.m., somebody fired shots, as a result of which, the glass panes of the door got smashed. The complainant observed that Tarlochan Singh, Karanveer and Pavittar Singh alongwith 6-7 unknown persons armed with iron rods had come there in two swift cars and after firing shots, they ran away.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that nobody had suffered any injury in the incident and matter has been compromised and quashing of FIR is being sought on the basis thereof. The petitioner is behind bars since 17.03.2018. Investigation is still going on and challan has not been filed, therefore, bail be granted.

Learned counsel for the complainant does not oppose the request.

Learned State counsel submits the petitioner is in judicial custody and challan has not been filed so far.

Under the circumstances, the petition is accepted. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/CJM/Duty Magistrate, SAS Nagar-Mohali, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) he shall appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing.
- (ii) he shall not give any threat or intimidation to the prosecution witnesses.
- (iii) he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender his passport, if he has got one otherwise to furnish affidavit in that regard.

In addition to that the trial Court may impose any term and condition found suitable to ensure that the petitioner does not abscond and interfere in the trial.

In case the petitioner violates any term and condition on which the bail has been granted to him, the order shall be liable to be withdrawn.
