This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.283 dated 10.8.2017 under sections 323, 342, 347, 395, 387, 379-A, 506, 120-B I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Murthal, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Uday Kumar Singh on the allegations that objectionable photographs of the complainant along with one girl named Ritu were taken and that he had been blackmailed. During the course of investigation Ritu and Veneet were nominated as accused. Name of the present petitioner does not even figure in the FIR. He is sought to be implicated on the statement of co-accused.

Main accused Ritu and Veneet have been granted benefit of regular bail.

Petitioner has faced incarceration since 16.9.2017.

Investigation in the case is complete and even the challan has been filed in the Court. Trial is at the very initial stage and would take time

to conclude.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sonapat.

Petition disposed of.
