Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners herein in case FIR No.234 dated 30.09.2017, under Sections 323, 324, 34 of IPC and Section 326 IPC added subsequently, registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Navneet Singh in relation to an occurrence dated 28.09.2017.

Precise allegations against the petitioners herein are of having inflicted iron needle/sua blows in the stomach as also right side of the face of the complainant.

Further allegation is that one Sukhwinder Singh tried to intervene and to save the complainant, he was also inflicted sua blows in the stomach by the present petitioners.

Counsel for the petitioners does not dispute that the injuries attributed to the present petitioners as per version of the

complainant find corroboration from medical record.

The injuries suffered by the complainant have been opined to be grievous in nature thereby attracting offence under Section 326 IPC.

In the light of such serious allegations as also gravity of the offence, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioners the concession of pre arrest bail.

Petition dismissed.
