The petitioner prays for issuance of directions to respondents No. 3 and 4 to expedite investigation in case FIR No. 0037 dated 19.02.2017 registered at Police Station City Kharar, District Sahibzada Ajit Singh Nagar, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC.

As per the allegations made in the petition, the private respondents and co-sharers of the petitioner in connivance with each other took the entire amount of compensation fraudulently in lieu of the the joint land acquired by PUDA/GMADA. Thus, the aforementioned FIR was registered.

Mr. Amandeep S. Gill, Sr. DAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 4. Let five copies of petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of order that is being passed there is no necessity to issue notice to private respondents No. 5 to 7 at this stage.

case not later than three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
