Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the ASI who is present in Court today to assist him, submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, pursuant to the order of this Court dated 18.04.2018, the motor-cycle used in the crime is still to be recovered.

Having considered the above, seeing the fact that the petitioner was not actually named in the FIR, though he possibly can be one of the other boys stated to be present along with those named, seeing the fact that he is not denied to be slightly above 15 years of age, the aforesaid order dated 18.04.2018, is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.

However, it is made clear that nothing stated hereinabove will be taken to be a comment of this Court on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, which would be wholly gone into by the investigating agency and the competent court at the proper stage.
