The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 265, dated 02.09.2017, under Sections 379-B, 411 IPC, registered at Police Station Chhahharta, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR against the petitioner are that he along with his co-accused had snatched the mobile phone of the complainant. He further contends that the petitioner is 25 years of age and has been in custody for over 04 months and he is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel has filed custody certificate of the petitioner, which indicates that the petitioner is in custody for over 04 months. He states that the investigation has been completed and the challan has been filed in Court.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner has been in custody for over 04 months, he is not involved in any other case, the investigation has been completed and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner, namely, Malkiat Singh @ Noni @ Ranjodh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
