Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in cross-case registered vide DDR No.25 dated 17.02.2018, under Sections 326, 323, 324, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar in case FIR No.109 dated 26.07.2014, under Sections 326, 323, 324/34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner stated that in pursuance of order dated 18.04.2018 of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.
