The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the event of arrest in FIR No. 22 dated 23.02.2018 under Sections 366, 363, 342, 506, 457, 380, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Chohla Sahib, Distric Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the daughter of the complainant has performed marriage with petitioner No.1 with her own consent. In pursuance of the earlier order, the daughter of the complainant along with petitioner No.1 is present in the Court today and she submits that she has performed the marriage with Petitioner No.1 and they

are living happily with each other. Learned counsel for the petitioners further contends that on the direction of this Court, the petitioners have has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that petitioner have joined the investigation and they are not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 18.04.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
