AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court alleging harassment at the hands of respondent No. 3-Incharge Police Chowki, Sultanwind, Police Station 'B' Division, Amritsar.

It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner that without there being any complaint or enquiry pending with respondent No. 3, he is, time and again, calling upon the petitioner, who is a lady, to come to the Police Station and is made to sit there. He contends that the petitioner would have no objection, in case the petitioner is called during the day time by serving a proper notice as per the provisions of Section 160 Cr. P.C.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner shall move a representation to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar highlighting her grievance, who may look into the same and pass an appropriate order.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting

thereon, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to move a representation to the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar highlighting her grievance, who shall look into the same and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law, if required.

In any case, if the petitioner is required for any enquiry on the basis of the complaint, proper notice under Section 160 Cr. P.C. be served upon her by respondent No. 3.
