Counsel for the petitioners contends that the parties have arrived at a compromise and they were only to give the bank guarantee and the bank guarantee was produced before the Mediators and is appended along with the Mediators report and the same has to be returned to the complainant. Counsel further states that guarantee was extended.

Counsel appearing for respondent No.2 has placed on record the copy of the guarantee, according to which it has been extended upto 07.11.2018.

The original guarantee is with the Bank.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that he wants to withdraw this petition as they have filed two separate petitions which are listed today for quashing of the FIR on the basis of the settlement arrived between the parties.

The Registry would return the bank guarantee (4 pages) appended along with the mediators report to the complainant. A copy of it be retained for record. It has to be returned to the complainant as per the agreement. The bank guarantee is valid till November, 2018. The complainant can approach the Bank for disbursement. If any help is required, the petitioner would extend the necessary help.

In view of the statement made above, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
