By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.136 dated 24.7.2016 registered under Sections 406, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 67 of Information Technology Act at Police Station Division-E, District Amritsar and all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 18.4.2018, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

Report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of complainant Gurmeet Kaur and also of the petitioners/accused namely Dharamveer Singh and Gurpreet Kaur @ Anju have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves. It has

specifically been opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.136 dated 24.7.2016 registered under Sections 406, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 67 of Information Technology Act at Police Station Division-E, District Amritsar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
