Application is allowed and reply on behalf of respondents No.5
and 6 is taken on record.

CRM-M-15403-2018

The petitioner-Rajender had filed this petition for issuance of
directions to locate his son namely Vijay and for taking action against private
respondents No.5 and 6, namely Balbir Singh and Rohtash.

It is pleaded that on 16.10.2017 the police officials came to the
house of the petitioner in connection with elopement of his son Vijay with
one Mamta wife of Balbir Singh.

The son of the petitioner is a truck driver. Status report has been
filed wherein it is revealed that at the instance of Balbir son of Parsadi Lal,
FIR No.412 dated 10.12.2017 was registered against Vijay son of the
petitioner as well as the petitioner, on the allegations that they allured Mamta
wife of Balbir who had also taken away cash and jewellery with her. Mamta

was recovered on 16.3.2018 and her statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. before the Magistrate does not implicate Vijay son of Rajender. It is also indicated that on the basis of the complaint by the petitioner, FIR No.328 dated 3.10.2018 has been registered against Mamta and Balbir which is under investigation. Besides, the statement of the petitioner Rajender has been recorded who has expressed his willingness not to pursue the case.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
