The petitioners seek direction to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

According to the petitioners, their son had illicit relations with one Paramjit Kaur, who is the daughter-in-law of respondent No.4. On this account, one FIR No.125 dated 26.11.2017, was registered at Police Station Kathgarh, District SBS Nagar, under Sections 497, 380 and 506 IPC against the son of the petitioners and Paramjit Kaur. However, the petitioners are being threatened and harassed in the said case, even though, they have disinherited their son a long time back.

Notice of motion.

Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.4 to 6, at this stage.

The petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 28.03.2018 (Annexure P-3) and ensure that

the petitioners are not harassed on account of lodging of the above-stated FIR. However, the police would be at liberty to investigate the said FIR in accordance with law without causing any inconvenience or harassment to the petitioners.
