The present petition filed under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 not to harass or interfere in the peaceful married life of the petitioners at the instance of respondents No.4 to 6 and other family members and not to intrude into the privacy of the petitioners by raiding their house time and again.

Learned State counsel has placed on record photocopy of the statements of the petitioners in which they have submitted that they do not apprehend any threat from the hands of private respondents and they do not require any police protection.

In this view of the matter, the present petition has rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.

However, in case any of the petitioners apprehend any threat to their limb, life and liberty in future, they may approach to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural and in that eventuality, be provided protection as prayed for.
