**AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (Oral)**

By this petition, quashing of FIR No.212 dated 19.12.2014, initially registered against the petitioners at Police Station Nathana, District Bhatinda, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 341/325/323/427/148/149 IPC, is sought, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners (accused) and respondent no.2 (complainant).

Vide an order of this Court dated 10.03.2016, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to get their statements recorded, in terms of the compromise.

Pursuant to that order of this Court dated 10.03.2016, and of 02.06.2016, the report of learned JMIC, Bhatinda, dated 01.07.2016, is on record stating to the effect that the complainant in the FIR, Naveen Kumar (respondent no.2 herein) has been recorded to the effect that he has

compromised the matter with the petitioners voluntarily, of his own free will.

The statements of the petitioners were also recorded supporting the compromise.

As per the assessment of the learned JMIC, Bhatinda, the compromise appears to be genuine and voluntary without any coercion and undue influence.

Though nothing in the statement of the complainant is seen with regard to whether the matter has been compromised with another co-accused of the petitioners, i.e. respondent no.3, Pawan Kumar, considering the nature of the offences alleged, I see no reason to continue with the criminal proceedings against the petitioners.

Consequently, keeping in view the ratio of the law laid down by the Supreme Court in Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and others, (2012) 10 SCC 303, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 212 dated 19.12.2014, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Nathana, District Bhatinda, for alleged alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 341/325/323/427/148/149 IPC, alongwith all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
