Counsel for the petitioners, very fairly, concedes that petitioner No. 2 is still a minor, however, he states that there is a threat to the life and liberty of petitioner No. 2 at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6. He contends that petitioner No. 2, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad-respondent No. 2 to look into the representation dated 13.04.2018 (Annexure P-4) submitted by her to ensure that the life and liberty of petitioner No. 2 is protected.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon especially with regard to the assertion with relation to the marriage performed between the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Superintendent of Police, Fatehabad to ensure that the life and liberty of petitioner No 2 is not put to jeopardy and the same is

protected in accordance with law.
