AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court challenging the order dated 19.09.2016 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib, by which the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender.

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is a resident of village Thandewala, Tehsil and District Sri Muktsar Sahib, whereas the bailable warrants as also the non-bailable warrants and proclamation were issued at a different address altogether. Counsel contends that the petitioner was not aware of any proceedings initiated against him and, therefore, because of not being aware of such proceedings, he could not appear before the trial Court. He states that the petitioner is ready and willing to appear before the trial Court and would make himself available on the date, which may be fixed by the trial Court for the proceedings which may ensue. His submission is that the petitioner would surrender before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib, on 02.05.2018 and move an application for grant of regular bail, which may be considered and decided at an early date.

In case the petitioner appears before the

Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib, on **02.05.2018** and moves an

application for grant of regular bail, the said application shall be accepted and he be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

It would be open to the Court to impose further conditions in accordance with law including seeking an undertaking from the petitioner that he would appear before the Court on each date of hearing.

The petitioner stands disposed of accordingly.
