The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondents No. 3 and 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner, her friend Birmati and her family members from the hands of respondents No. 5 to 8 and their associates.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has already approached respondent No. 3-Superintendent of Police, Kaithal by way of her representation (Annexure P-1) for redressal of her grievance, however, no action has been taken thereunder so far. It is submitted that the petitioner would feel satisfied, at the present moment, in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 3 to decide the said representation expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. P. P. Chahar, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Let a copy of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day, failing which, no action is called for. Counsel for the respondents-State assures this Court that in case there is any threat perception, the petitioner will be provided adequate protection.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is being disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 to decide the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-1) by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks and if there is any threat perception as alleged, adequate protection be provided to the petitioner and her family members.
