The petitioner seeks protection of his life and liberty and that of his workmen at the hands of the private respondents.

According to the petitioner, he was awarded the labour/cartage contract for handling and transportation of food-grains at Storage Center at Bhucho and Bathinda vide letter dated 09.04.2018 (Annexure P-1). Ever since, the private respondents, who are members of the Punjab Pradesh Palledar Labour Union, Bhucho, have been trying to disrupt his activities.

Notice of motion. Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Let four copies of the petition be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity to call upon respondent Nos.4 to 19, at this stage.

The petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3 to objectively consider the representations dated 11.04.2018 (Annexure P-2) and 16.04.2018 (Annexure P-3) and to take appropriate steps in accordance

with law to ensure that the lawful activities of the petitioner are not disrupted in an unlawful manner.
