The petitioner having jumped bail, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that actually as a matter of fact his counsel had noted the date wrongly, due to which he could not appear on one date he having appeared on all dates previous to that.

Whereas the possibility of having noted a wrong date cannot be ruled out, however, it is seen that it has also become a usual excuse for non-appearance.

Be that as it may, while dismissing this petition, it is directed that upon the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court and presenting an application under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the trial Court would go into the reasoning given by the petitioner and take a decision thereon immediately, keeping in view the contention raised before this Court that the petitioner had been appearing on each and every date prior to the one date that he did not appear.
