DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in compliance of order dated 19.4.2018, the petitioners have joined the investigation and the same has been affirmed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners on the ground that the petitioners are habitual offenders and two more cases are pending against them.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that two FIRs are pending against petitioner No.1. In one case, compromise has been

effected between the parties and in another he is facing trial and is on regular bail.

Keeping in view the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and also the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and recovery has also been effected, interim order dated 19.4.2018 passed in favour of the petitioners is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
