The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.44 dated 31.3.2018 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda.

Heard.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bhatinder Singh states that the deficient amount has already been recovered from the owner of the truck. He further states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the order dated 20.4.2018 is made absolute till the

presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:-

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation as and when required by the police;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the prior permission of the trial Court.
- (iv) that the petitioner will seek regular bail on the presentation of challan in Court.
