Petitioner-Jagseer Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.144 dated 21.07.2016, registered at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana, under Sections 306 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR has been registered on the statement of complainant-Jatinder Singh regarding commission of suicide by his father. The allegation against the present petitioner is

regarding abetment of committing suicide.

The main witnesses i.e. complainant and his wife Anjali Arora have not supported the case of prosecution while appearing in the Court and turned hostile.

The petitioner has been in custody since 28.11.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
