The petitioner has filed third petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.16, dated 18.01.2017 registered under Sections 148, 149, 285, 323, 307, 379-B & 506 IPC and Sections 25-54-59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Nissing, District Karnal.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

This Court did not accede to the request for grant of regular bail on earlier occasions because the evidence of the material witnesses was not recorded. Now the evidence of the witnesses has been recorded. I have gone through the evidence of the material witnesses. The attribution to the petitioner is that he had given iron rod blow on the shoulder. Prima facie, the case is made out for grant of bail.

In that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL. MISC. No.M-15611 OF 2018 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner to surrender his passport with the trial Court, if he possesses the same.
