Though learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is no differently placed to all the other co-accused who have been granted bail (one Lovedeep Singh having been admitted to bail by this Court and the others earlier having been granted bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur), learned State counsel however submits that the petitioner being the incharge of the Malkhana, should not have handed over the key to his son and therefore he cannot be treated on par with the other co-accused.

Learned counsel for the petitioner however submits that the petitioner has already been dismissed from service and now nothing further is to be recovered from him, with the charge also framed today as per his instructions.

Keeping in view the fact that all other co-accused have been

with nothing to be now recovered from him and all prosecution witnesses to be still examined, I consider it appropriate to admit him to bail, upon his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.

Ordered accordingly.
